

## Outdoor Learning Programme

Our secure 25-acre site, with over 200 species of flora and an incredible 900+ species of invertebrates, provides a unique environment perfectly suited to our activities, with curriculum linked workshops designed for key stage 1 and 2. (Some workshops can also be tailored for EYFS).

### PRIMARY EDUCATION SESSIONS

At our free pre-visit meeting we discuss the needs of your group and adapt all activities to the age/ability of your students. Choose from:

#### 1hr workshops- £1.50 per child

- \***Mission Minibeast**- habitats and how to find and identify a range of invertebrates.
- \***Bugs on Bushes**- use sweeping nets and beating to collect and identify a range of invertebrates.
  - \***Birds, bees and butterflies** - life cycles, classification and pollination.
  - \***Wonderful Worms** - decomposition and soil.
  - \***Fun with Food Chains** - wood and meadow food webs and chains.
  - \***Art adventures** - natural and ephemeral art activities.
  - \***Pond Pioneers** - pond dipping.
- \***Snails, Slugs and Slime** - learn about adaptation and make slime to take away (50p extra per pupil).
- \***Campfire Capers** - mini bushcraft session with fun around the campfire, food and songs.

#### 2 hr workshops- £3 per child

- \***Meadow Magic** - sensory stories/ science and art themed adventure.
- \***Wild about Woods** - Science and Geography themed adventure.
- \***Forest school tasters/ blocks** (£2.50 per session for blocks of 6 sessions).

#### All day workshop- £4.50 per child

- \***Eco-Explorer Day** - science, history, geography, art, bush craft. Linked to season and school topic etc.
- \***Eco-Explorer award** - visit for an Eco Explorer Day in Spring, Summer and Autumn to earn the award (3<sup>rd</sup> visit free).
